- Virtual Costume Contest Across the System <u>Tuesday, October 31st</u>
 - Skits- 12 people or less
 - Group Costumes:
 - Small group: 1- 5 Large groups: 6-12
 - Individual Costumes

- Recorded and shared internally for Employee Voting November 3.
- LIVE streamed to patient rooms via CLZTV
- **Employee Only Event**

When: Tuesday, October 31st at 2:30pm Location: Front of the Medical Center – Outdoor in Circle Drive Participant check-in location: The Green Space near Camelot Court entrance at 2:10pm

Costume Contest:

- Option to pre-register or register in-person on day of event before 1:00pm on October 31st In order for the production crew and event host to prepare for the live-stream, we will not be able to accept walk up entries upon arrival at the event.
- Arrive to check in by 2:10pm and look for a volunteer with your contest category sign to line up in order
- We will snap photos of all entries on stage for employee voting on CookNet

- Deadline to submit in person and virtual skit registration forms: October 18
- If planning to record original music with Raymond Turner, schedule a time to record by October 16
- Skit themes & music must be approved in advance*

Virtual Contest

Virtual Costume Contest: <u>Submit through Tuesday, October 31</u>

- Costumes can be worn to work **October 28-October 31**
- Registration forms are located on CookNet
- Costumes must be child friendly
- Photo submissions please be aware of your background and do not include any patient/confidential information

Virtual Award Categories:

- <u>Employee Favorite</u>: Best Individual Costume, Best Group Costumes (small & large) and Best Skit
 - Selection committee will select top 20 submissions in each category for CookNet voting
- Patients Choice: Best Individual Costume, Best Group Costume, Best Skit

Deadline to submit registration and photo for virtual costume contest is 10/31 (23:59) <u>Amy.Smith@cookchildrens.org</u>



Virtual Skit Contest: <u>Submit video through Tuesday, October 31</u> Registration forms are located on CookNet Due: <u>October 18</u>

- No more than 12 group members
- Skit must be under 5 minutes in length
- Costumes and music must be child friendly
- Contest participants must be employees only
- Video submissions will be posted for employee voting on CookNet starting Nov 3 – See registration form for submission details.



Group Skit Contest Guidelines

Step 1: Submit registration form:

All skit themes and music must be approved by Amy Walker or Amy Smith by Wednesday, October 18th

- Group sizes limited to **<u>12 people</u>**
- Safety note: Please note that the stage size is 24' x 16' and elevated 30" off the ground. Contestants can access the stage using stairs located on both sides of the stage. There will be railing around the border of the stage in the back and on each side.
 We suggest taping out the size of the stage when practicing
- Skits should be no longer than <u>5 minutes in length</u>
- All music/audio used for skits must be child appropriate and edited from the original for copyright purposes submit to Raymond Turner by October 23.
- If planning to record original music/audio with Raymond Turner, please schedule a time to record by October 16th
- 2 handheld microphones will be provided
- Historically, successful Hoopla skits have pre-recorded any spoken words with Raymond Turner for their performance in place of using a live microphone – Groups may also record/edit on their own device as long as it is submitted by the October 23rd deadline
- Group practices must be held off campus and off the clock
- Hoopla participation is voluntary and therefore Cook Children's cannot provide compensation for hours spent beyond typical working hours on meetings and/or practice
- All video taken for virtual elements is property of Cook Children's and will be shared on CookNet or as determined by the Internal Communications team
- Contest participants must be employees only
- Themes/attire must be child appropriate
- Only group members listed on the registration form will be eligible for prizes
- Determine a team captain who will notify Amy Smith to que the music on the right side of the stage when you are ready to begin





Group Skit Contest Guidelines Continued

- Step 2: Arrive to check in by <u>2:10pm</u> and look for a volunteer with your contest category sign to line up in order.
 - Come prepared with music/props/attire for your skit- you will have a 2-3 minute set-up time.
 - The event is being recorded and will be shared on CookNet, by registering you are giving your media consent
 - There will not be time to practice day of on stage, please plan accordingly
 - Personal recording devices will be not be permitted
 - Music:
 - If you plan to record original music with Raymond, please schedule a time to record by **October 16.**
 - Final music must be submitted to Amy Smith by <u>October 23.</u> with notes for AV team (if any)

• Step 3: Tell your peers to log on to CookNet and vote November 3-7
