All of our volunteer placements are available to employees who qualify. Here are some of the ways employee volunteers are giving back and impacting the patient/family experience.

- **Hospitality cart:** Round on inpatient units distributing self-care and comfort items to parents and caregivers, so they can better cope with the mental and physical stress of having a hospitalized child.
- **Patient support:** Interact with patients and siblings at bedside and in playrooms by playing games, doing art projects, or watching their favorite movies.
- **Toy box team:** Clean and disinfect toys so that patients have more variety to choose from for playtime.
- **Panda Cares Center of Hope Sibling Support Center:** Engage siblings in fun activities to pass the time while parents and patients go to appointments at the Dodson Clinics.
- **Emergency Department waiting room:** Support patients and families in the emergency department waiting areas by offering art activities, snacks/drinks, blankets and more.
- **Fort Worth Urgent Care Centers:** Interact with patients and families as they wait to be seen by clinical staff. Provide fun activities from the art cart.
