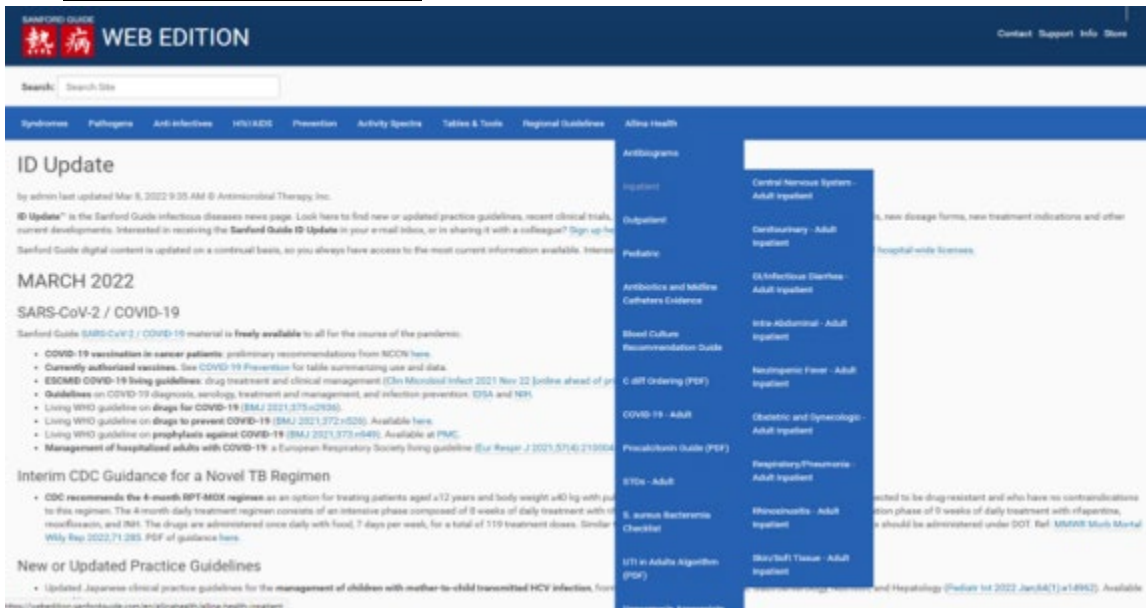


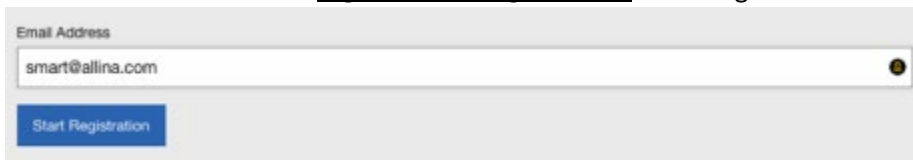

3. Finish the app registration on line and follow activation instructions.
